## Things you should know:

- 1. Leno's Plant Farm in Mansfield will provide and deliver the flowers to CHHS this year.
- 2. All flats have 18 individual 4" plants which we sell for \$20/flat.
- 3. Each student that didn't purchase a buy-out booster club membership (Conductor level) is asked to sell at least 20 flats.

## Things you should do:

- 1. Spread the word about our flower fundraiser!
- 2. Have each customer fill out a line on the order form.
- 3. For each customer, please confirm a) the type of flowers, b) the number of flats, and c) the payment is correct.
- 4. Collect payments at time of order (cash or check checks made out to CHHS panther choir).
- 5. Let the customer know that you will deliver the flowers on Saturday, October 15th.

## Order forms and money will need to be turned in by no later than Friday. October 7th.

Instructions for turning in order forms and money:

- 1. Fill in student name, phone number and class, as well as parent name and phone number, at the bottom of the order form.
- 2. Tally your orders across and at the bottom of the form. Double check your totals and that the money collected adds up.
- 3. Place order form and money in an envelope.

Flower delivery is set for the morning of Saturday, October 15th in the big parking lot behind CHHS near the choir room (subject to change if weather is bad.) A Sign Up Genius will be sent out for volunteers to help with flower sorting and pick-up. Parents and students are encouraged to help.
